

Participatory Budgeting Vote Outcome

Following allocation of funds to levels 1 and 2 applications, £325,878.05 has been available for applicants who submitted Level 3 applications during the current round. The following is a breakdown of the voting results in a participatory budgeting opportunity that ran from 1st December to 15th December 2023.

Eighteen eligible applications entered the voting process, which was open to people who live, work or access services in Aberdeenshire. To be classed as an eligible vote, the submission had to include a postcode from Aberdeenshire, which we have then checked against a number of different sources and mapped so that each organisation could see where they had secured votes from.

Whilst 4,379 voters took part in the vote, 356 voters didn't enter a valid postcode on their voting form, meaning that 4,023 eligible voters took part and 20,115 eligible votes were received (each voter was required to vote for 5 separate projects).
